PRESS RELEASE – FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Monday, November 6, 2017 at 5:45 pm, Roseville Police responded to a report of a hit and run injury accident in the parking lot of the local Uber Office, located at 2055 Rice Street in Roseville. When officers arrived, they located a 22 year old St. Paul woman in the parking lot with significant injuries resulting from being struck by a vehicle. The victim was transported to Regions Hospital, where she continues to recover from her injuries.

Just prior to the incident, the victim, who was an Uber employee, had a brief conversation in the parking lot with an unidentified male who was sitting in a vehicle. As the victim was walking back into the building, the male quickly accelerated towards the victim and intentionally ran her over. He then fled in his vehicle, headed southbound on Rice Street. The suspect vehicle was described as a smaller, gold, mid 2000s SUV or minivan.

The Roseville Police are looking for the public's help in either identifying the suspect or the vehicle. The Roseville Police Department would also like to talk to anyone who was traveling in the area on November 6th and may have seen anything related to the incident.
