Welcome to the 15th annual **Holiday Craft Fair**, supporting the Harriet Alexander Nature Center (HANC)! During the 2-day sale you'll find over 55 crafters and artists spread throughout the building on two levels and even some outside the building. There is an elevator in the middle of the building along with staircases on either side.



Upper Level - *hallways and conference rooms*

Holly Brabeck – flour sack dish towels; hanging crochet-topped towels; handmade soaps; decorative coasters
